

The 70-20-10 Rule

Research¹ indicates that the best development experiences consist of:

- 70% on-the-job experience (challenging assignments, etc.)
- 20% support (feedback, mentoring, coaching, etc.)
- 10% formal training (seminars, webinars, etc.).

Unfortunately, many leadership development programs apply the 70-20-10 rule in reverse, with heavy emphasis on formal training, and little or no support or on-thejob experience. As a result, development ends when the leader leaves the classroom.




